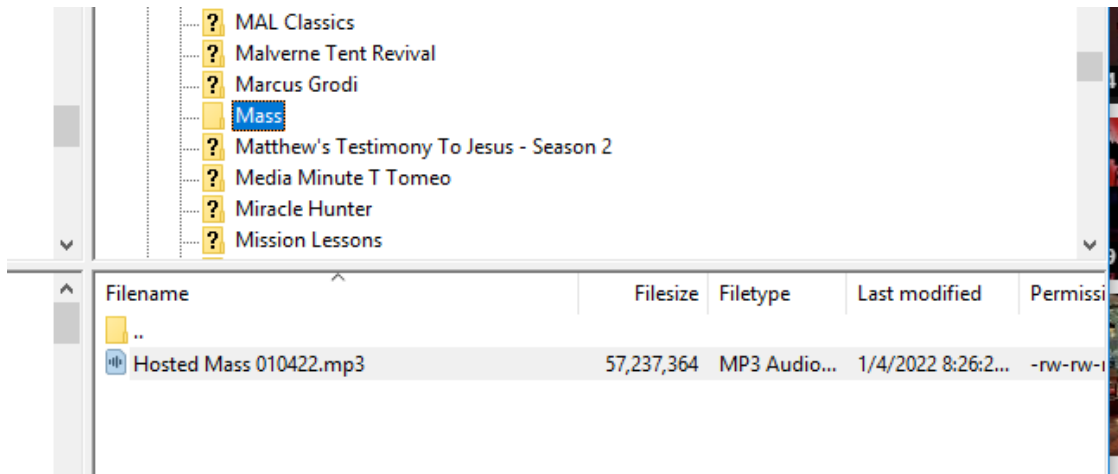
To access our FTP site:

SPECIAL ALERT

Sun Outage Notice for EWTN Radio Satellite Downlink

If you receive EWTN Radio via satellite, during the first few weeks in March, 2022, satellite reception across the continental United States may be interrupted for a short duration due to solar outages. This interference occurs twice per year usually in the Spring/March and in the Fall/October when the sun comes in line with the transponding equatorial positioned satellite and a downlink satellite dish. Signal loss duration and time depends on the geographical location of your satellite dish. Solar outages may occur plus or minus one day and up to five minutes from the calculated times.

Solar Outage will not affect Barix usage.
